JL has a further meeting on 11/11/21 via Zoom with Katie Macdonald, & Eddie Northwood from the Consultation Team. (1039) Community Project Fund Working Group. KH reported that only 2 projects had received funding to date, but the MPC are still awaiting an outcome. WD reported no further updates on the submission for signage of footpaths etc around the village. (1040) Local Plan Working Group The response to the MVDC Local Plan under Regulation 19, from the Mickleham Parish Council has been submitted on 05/11/21 following various meetings with Margaret Cooksey and Hazel Watson. All submissions will be reviewed in April 2022 and a recommendation sent to the

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Inspectorate. A decision is expected late Summer 2022. DI thanked GC/AM for putting the documents together on behalf of the MPC. (1041) Mole Valley Boundary Review Working Group KH reported back following emails/meetings. It was agreed to put forward the 2 proposals for MPC: to form a 2-councillor ward to include Mickleham, Westhumble, Headley & Box Hill. Geographically all suitable. to form a 3-councillor ward to include Box Hill, Westhumble, Pixham, Westcott, Leith Hill & Wotton. The deadline for comments is 6th December 2021. **Coronavirus Update** 7 (1042) WD updated the meeting with events proposed by St Michael's Church Community Group for the Platinum Jubilee on 2nd to 5th June 2022: Village Tea party 4th June with children's games on the Recreation ground. Possible event in the Village Hall for older age group / Dinner Dance TBC. Service on Sunday June 5th. Traffic Issues including Parking and Noise 8 (1043) Traffic Proposal Submitted Nov 2020 – Update The Clerk updated the meeting from the last reply from Surrey Highways: 01st November 2021. Any requests received to introduce new parking restrictions must go through a statutory legal process of advertising. When a request is submitted, they are included in a parking review and does not mean that they automatically get implemented. The proposals are subject to a 28-day period of advertising, during which time members of the public can agree or object to the proposals. The MPC request was added to the latest review, but there has been a delay due to Covid, so the earliest opportunity for it to be agreed for advertising by the committee was on 29th September. Advertising starts on 11th November, for a period of 28 days to the 09th December, after which time the appropriate parties can examine the results. It is hoped that any implementation would take place before the end of the financial year.
